
## 58" x 70" Beginner-Friendly Black & White Irish Chain Quilt

BECAUSE WE'RE CUTTING APART A SEWN SEAM I RECOMMEND USING A LOWER STITCH LENGTH - I USE 1.5 TO PREVENT THE ENDS FROM UNRAVELLING.




• **BINDING:** 2.5" strips x 8 (or whatever size you like to use)


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (all rounded up to be safe)

- Irish Chain Interior + 2" Border: 3 yards white, 1 yard black
- 6" Outer Border: 1.5 yards
- **Backing:** 2.25 yards 108" backing 2 yards if you're ok with back turned sideways
- Batting: a little less than backing
- Binding: 2/3 yards

1ST ROW STARTS WITH WHITE SQUARE, 2ND ROW STARTS WITH 9 PATCH



THE IRISH CHAIN PORTION IS MADE OF 32 - 6.5" WHITE SQUARES AND WE'LL NEED 31 - 9 PATCHES THAT END UP 6.5" SQUARE




A = Black-White-Black strip sets B = White-Black-White strip sets


For the 31 nine patches we'll cut 10 black 2.5" strips WOF, and 8 white. From those strips we sew 4 black strip sets and 2 white, then subcut the strip sets into 2.5" rows. Each strip set should yield 16 rows if the usable fabric is at least 40" long. If it's less you'll need to adjust the fabric requirements accordingly.

## **IRISH CHAIN PORTION WILL HAVE 7 COLUMNS, 9 ROWS**


INTERIOR SECTION WILL MEASURE 42.5" X 54.5" (unfinished)
